RECYCLE. REUSE. REDUCE. REPURPOSE

Please don't throw away any unwanted books or jigsaw puzzles. Unwanted books and puzzles can be recycled using the marked plastic container, under a bench in the breezeway passageway into the church hall. When the container fills up, the books and puzzles are taken to the Lifeline book depot in Lindfield, then cleaned, sorted, priced and sold in either the Lifeline bookshop in Lindfield or at one of Lifeline's local book fairs. You'd be amazed at the interest in old, unusual or plain books! All funds raised go to support Lifeline's counselling work.

SAFE MINISTRY MOMENT

Each first Monday of the month, our staff read over and discuss a child safe standard that has formed a significant part of the response to the Royal Commission into Institutional Child Sex Abuse. This week we discussed Child Safe Standard 3: Families and Communities are informed and involved.

Our Safe Ministry Rep, Meg Webster, has given us three simple questions to think through as a team:
What does this standard mean to us at St Andrew's?
What do we already do well?
What could we be doing better?

It is always a helpful conversation!

This standard particularly highlights the risk where organisations are closed and have a lack of transparency with families and communities. And something we discussed at length that this is "particularly the case in situations where families and the community have an unquestioning respect for the authority of that organisation."

It is so important that all people; kids, youth and adults alike, feel that they can ask questions and raise any concerns at church. The staff, parish council or wardens want to know and listen to anything you want to share, and of course, any safety concerns. What could be more important than ensuring our gospel work honours God by being safe, careful and righteous in all that we do.
