John wrote this while working for the Department of Evangelism in 1999. The course focuses on promoting the gospel in our lives and what we say. It helps us to bring 'God Talk' into our conversations and use 'Gospel Bites' to connect people with the teaching of Jesus. This afternoon aimed to help people actively promote the gospel in the community and look for opportunities to share their faith or invite people to church through this. 

BUSH WALK

Are you interested in joining the St Andrew's walking group for an early morning walk from the Spit Bridge to Manly, on Saturday September 21?

Meet at 8am at Grumpy's Wharf Cafe on the South (Mosman) side of the Spit Bridge on Spit Rd.

There is free parking on Parriwi Road (East Side) or paid parking at Spit West Car Park. Car sharing is encouraged.

The iconic Spit to Manly coastal Scenic Walkway is one of the most spectacular Sydney Harbour foreshore walks. This is a great opportunity to enjoy fellowship and the beauty of God's creation as we walk along a lovely stretch of Sydney Harbour. There are of course magnificent harbour views, but also a number of other surprises. There are sandy beaches, protected coves, sandstone cliffs, caves and waterfalls, as well aboriginal engravings. The walkway passes through patches of gully rainforest, open woodland , heath and coastal scrub. As you approach Manly, the pathway winds through lovely suburban streets.

This is about a 9km walk and will take up to 4 hours. Moderate fitness is required, as there are lots of stairs. Coffee and lunch are options at the end of the walk in Manly, before a 20 minute bus ride on the 144 back to the Spit Bridge. Nick Barbarino will lead the walk.

Please wear appropriate footwear and bring water, a snack, hat and sunscreen.

TOILETING PROCEDURES WHEN KIDS ARE IN OUR PROGRAMS

As you all know, we take safety on our site incredibly seriously, and are always seeking to reduce risk for our kids, youth and vulnerable adults (and of course, everyone who comes onsite!)

When children in are in our programs, where possible we have separated the bathrooms that children are to use from those of adults/ leaders.

But during church on a Sunday morning there is obvious complexities with our site!

Whenever kids are in Kids Church, if kids need to use the bathrooms, leaders will:

- walk them to the main bathrooms in the hall
- ensure there are no adults in either of the cubicles
- wait outside and ask any adults who'd like to use the bathrooms to wait until the kids are done

Thank you for your patience and grace with the team - you'll never have to wait very long to use the bathrooms, and outside of when kids are in programs, it's entirely up to parents how they navigate the space. We appreciate your partnership and care in keeping our kids safe.

REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE

Are you composting your food waste? If not, there are very good reasons to start. Composting recycles kitchen and yard vegetation waste and reduces our dependency on landfill waste. Compost systems recycle essential nutrients back into the soil, enriching and building healthy soil and improving healthy plant growth.
