 - The conflict around Barhir Dar continues and there has been sporadic conflict even within the city limits. Please pray for safety for the staff we support and of course the patients.
 - There are curfews limiting transport meaning that some women have to walk hours while in labour to get to the hospital.
 - Recently the government deregulated the currency.
 This is putting a great strain on the country.


CHURCH-WIDE PRAYER & PRAISE NIGHT
