**FIRST-AID KITS**

We take health and safety very seriously at St Andrew's. In each main ministry space there is a first-aid kit, labelled with the space it is meant to be in.

**Please ensure the first-aid kits stay in their designated areas, so that we can keep track of them.**

There are also a couple of first-aid kits specifically set aside for any off-site activities, should you need them. If so, please tell the ministry staff responsible for the activity.

**RECYCLING TIP**

Single-use disposable coffee cups should not be put in your kerbside recycling bin. The best way to reduce disposable coffee cup waste is to use a reusable cup or crockery.

However, if you do continue to use a single-use disposable coffee cup, they can be recycled through 'Simply Cups'. Check out the 'Simply Cups' website ([simplycups.com.au](http://simplycups.com.au)) to find locations where you can take your disposable coffee cups. Simply Cups does use some 7-Eleven locations for depositing cups. The cups collected are used in asphalt, EnviroLite concrete and blocks, as well as in packing materials.
