PARISH COUNCIL REPORT

During its meeting on the 18th of November, the Parish Council considered the response to the Vision Day Appeal and the budget for 2025. Firstly, a massive thanks to all who have supported the Vision Day Appeal. We are so thankful for your partnership in the gospel. In addition, we certainly understand that many people would like to give but are unable to because of the difficulties they are facing at this time,.

Sadly, the Vision Day Appeal is presently more than 50% short of the target, which means that the Parish Council needs to make some very tough decisions about which ministries St Andrew's can sustainably support and invest in next year.

So much so that the Parish Council is having a special meeting on Monday, 25th of November, to finalise and approve the budget for next year. This gives the saints of St Andrew's just a few more days to respond to the Vision Day Appeal before the Parish Council makes these tough decisions and finalises the budget.

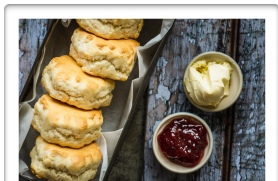

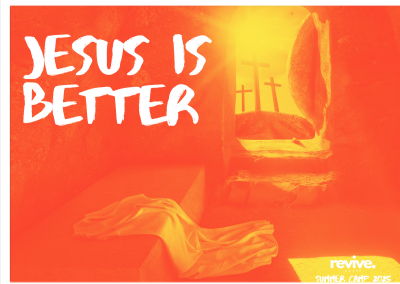

RECYCLING TIP

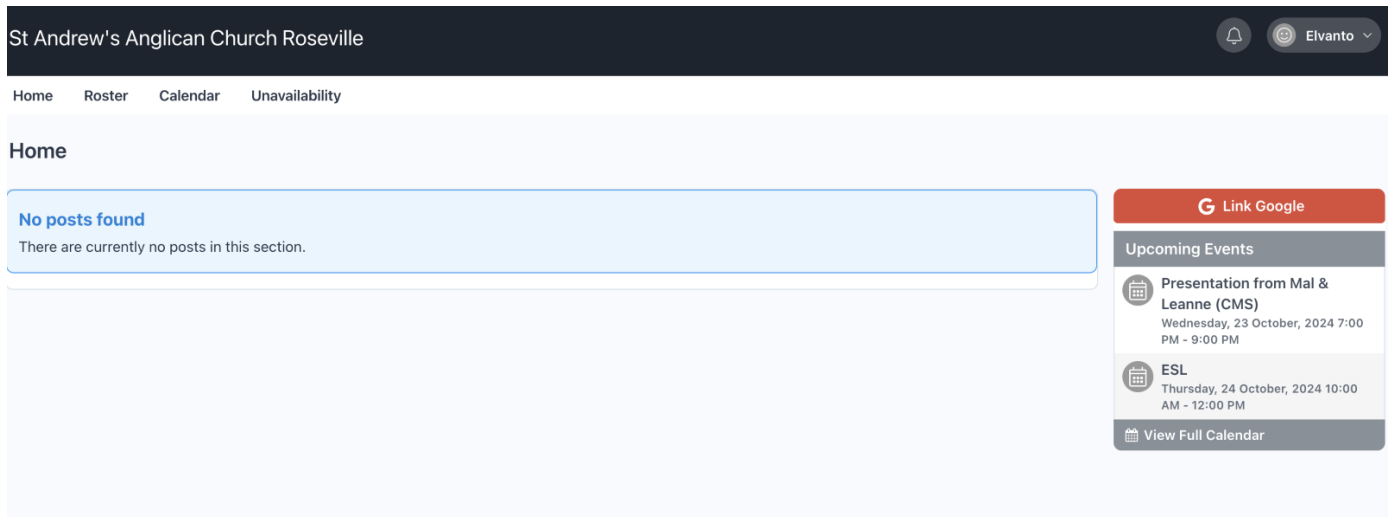
Whirl Recycling offers free electronics recycling, as a social enterprise, to the whole community. Electronics contain hazardous materials like lead, mercury and cadmium, which leach into soil, water and air when sent to landfill. If you are disposing of smart phones or computers, Whirl Recycling ensures that your data is securely destroyed following international standards, safeguarding privacy while supporting ethical and sustainable reuse and recycling practices. Starting in 2019, Whirl Recycling has saved over 8000 tonnes and 2.5 million electronics and appliances from landfill. Money raised is used to support local charities. The service has been used by members of the congregation, who have recommended using Whirl Recycling. If you live in the postcodes they collect from, they will pick up from you. There are also drop-off locations. If you have unwanted electronics to be recycled, you can checkout their website, whirlrecycling.com

MEMBER USE OF ELVANTO

As outlined on Vision Day, we plan to start utilising the member facilities of Elvanto (our church management system), which will enable members to engage with ministry and each other using a central platform.

On the **1st of February 2025**, we intend to activate the Member Area which looks something like this (please note it is unpopulated in this pic!):



As you can see the Member Area will allow you to:

- See upcoming events and access the church calendar
- Manage your own profile and settings
- See your upcoming roster
- Inform us of your unavailability

To interact with the Member Area, you will be sent an Elvanto login with a username and a link to set your own password. You can then access Elvanto either in a web browser or by using their app.

We also plan on the **1st of February 2025**, to enable the Member Directory which is basically a church member contact list allowing members to engage with each other in a more streamlined way. It will list your name (first and last) and your email address.

Please note:

- It is for adult members only (no kids/youth will be listed)
- It is for church and social use only (not for commercial use)
- The staff will withdraw access for anyone who misuses it

If you would like to OPT OUT of the Member Directory, please do so by filling in [this form](#).

We understand there are valid reasons to opt out of a shared contact list and we respect your preference. You will still be able to engage with the Member Area even if you opt out of the Member Directory. Of course, it will be possible to opt-out at any time, even after we go live.
