A BRIEF HISTORY OF LENT

Why Giving Things Up is a Spiritual Discipline

Lent is one of those ancient rhythms of the church calendar that has endured for centuries—forty days of preparation leading up to Easter, mirroring Christ's forty days in the wilderness (Matthew 4:1-11). It's a season marked by fasting, prayer, and repentance, deeply rooted in the early church's practice of self-denial as a way of drawing nearer to God.

By the second century, Christians were already observing some form of fasting before Easter, though the length varied. By the fourth century, after the Council of Nicaea (325 AD), Lent was formally established as a forty-day period. The focus was clear: self-denial is a path of spiritual renewal.

When we fast, whether from food, social media, or distractions, we reorder our desires. We learn that we are not mastered by what we consume, but by Christ. We strip away excess, so we can hunger for what truly satisfies. In a world that tells us to indulge, Lent whispers a countercultural truth: sometimes, losing is the way to gain.

Jesus Himself said, "Whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it" (Matthew 16:25). The practice of giving things up isn't about deprivation for its own sake; it's about making space for something better.

When we let go of comfort, we learn where our true security lies. When we step back from distractions, we become more attuned to God's Spirit. When we fast from what is good, we remember that only God is ultimate.

Lent is a season of subtraction, but paradoxically, it enriches rather than diminishes. Freedom isn't found in having more, but in needing less so we can focus. We find ourselves more fully in Christ, the one who gave everything so that we might gain everything in him.
